





### Services for visitors who are deaf or hard of hearing

- Most exhibition audio is accessible to t-coil hearing aid users.
- Assistive listening devices and neckloops are available in the auditorium.
- All exhibition films and videos are open captioned. Transcripts of *New York Story* are available. Please ask a staff member for assistance.

### Services for visitors who are blind or have low vision

- Text for major exhibitions is available in Large Print. Please inquire at the Admissions desk.

### Services for visitors with mobility impairments

- The building, galleries, and auditorium are wheelchair accessible, and a wheelchair accessible entrance is located at 2 West 77th Street. Wheelchairs are available to visitors free of charge. We recommend reserving in advance by calling (212) 485-9200.

### Gallery Policies

- Photography**  
Visitors are welcome to take photos of most exhibitions and objects, except where noted. The use of flash, tripods, and selfie-sticks is not permitted.
- Bag and coat check**  
Complimentary coat check is available at the Admissions desk. We ask that all backpacks, umbrellas, and large bags be checked.
- Strollers**  
All of our galleries are stroller-friendly. We regret that we are not able to check strollers in the coat check.
- Baby-changing facilities**  
Baby-changing facilities are located in the restrooms on the Lower Level and on Level One.
- Mobile devices**  
While we encourage the use of mobile devices to access information about collections and exhibitions, please do not place phone calls in the galleries.
